My dear Prof. Occhialini:

Your letter of Nov. 22nd reached me with considerable delay, as I was finishing the spring campaign in the western zone of the Argentine frontier. Because of the rains and electrical storms work in that region, at altitudes reaching 5800 m above sea level, has been interrupted. We are continuing in the eastern sector where the altitude reaches 4500 m.

We should be very glad to lend all possible assistance in the important investigation on cosmic radiation that you propose making in our country. The transportation (by railway) of the person elected for this work and the instruments from Buenos Aires to La Quiaca, as well as the journey by automobile and mule-back to the frontier zone, would be at our expense.

The work on the boundary line is continuing without interruption, so that you may begin your investigations at your convenience.
