Dear Zarisky,

It is really a pleasant duty for me to write to you to day in name of Prof. Dreyfus, Director of our Faculty of Sciences, in order to comunicate that the President of the Republic gave his final approval to your contract. This approval was published today in the Diario Oficial. The contract is for 1 year begining with January 1th in accordance with your wishes (We would like a longer period). Prof. Dreyfus who is exceptionally busy to day begs me to inform you that he wrote to the Ministerio de Negocios Exteriores (Itamaraty) in Rio asking to provide that the Brazilian Consul in Philadelphia gives a permanent visa for you. He wrote also to the State Department in order to ask if the State Department could provide for the travelling expenses for you and your family, because this University could not cover these expenses.

The lectures begin on March 15. *to* If ~~you~~ arrive some time before *Jan 15*
We all We will welcome you. I hope to see with you also Prof. André Weil
and I beg you to transmit to him my kindest regards.
