Dear Professor Bohm,

I was informed by Dr. Tiomno that you are interested in having a position in a Brazilian University. It happens that we are interested in having the collaboration of a professor of Theoretical Physics in our Department within the shortest possible interval of time. You are well known in our Department through the informations we have from Drs. Tiomno and Schützer about you and through your papers. They are very interested in working with you and agree that it would be of great value your collaboration.

I would like to know if you authorize me to propose your contract for a three years' period as a full professor of Theoretical and Mathematical Physics in the Faculdade de Filosofia, Ciências e Letras of the University of S. Paulo. The contract can be renewed at the end of this period. If a shorter period is more convenient for you I trust that this can be arranged. The bureaucratic details for the approval of the contract may take a month or two. The salary is one hundred and seventy thousand cruzeiros a year (about eight thousand and five hundred dollars, at the official exchange rate).

We shall be very glad in having your collaboration in our Department. We need an answer from you as soon as possible. In the case of an affirmative one please send your curriculum vitae and your list of papers.
