This will acknowledge your letter dated September 26th
in which you advise that you received a letter from Allis-Chalmers
regarding the betatron.

Since receipt of your letter, we have received a telephone
call from Allis-Chalmers requesting specific information necessary for
them to produce the material desired. They advise that no reply has been
received from you, and we suggest that you furnish us with the following
information so that we may transmit it to Allis-Chalmers.

1. The specifications on the betatron, as furnished
by you, indicate currency 60 cycles, A. C. Allis-
Chalmers have furnished a considerable amount of
material for Brazil, and all their specifications covered
50 cycles. They would like verification of the proper
cycle before proceeding.
2. Is transformer on the unit substage for indoor or
outdoor use?
3. Size of conduit on high voltage transformer.
4. Outside diameter of three-phase cable.
5. Diameter of copper conductor in cable.

Upon receipt of this information, we believe the Allis-Chalmers
Company will be in a position to complete the order without further
question.
