In connection with your letter of the 13th of January I am afraid that the Rockefeller Institute merely ran across an old memorandum regarding some information I asked of them some time ago as all questions on your order are entirely settled at this time. I, of course, received your letter of September 6th last year answering same on October 31st and you acknowledge this answer by your letter of November 8th.

While our strike at our Milwaukee Plant is still going on it looks as though it will be cleaned up by next week as an election is being held Sunday, the 26th, to determine a new bargaining agent and the International Union is getting very much interested in the hopes of settling the strike before the election can take place.

You will of course get the very latest development in the Betatron as improvements which have been added since our first ones and any ones that we can now design will be incorporated in your unit. I might say that the Betatron which was shipped to the Picatinny Arsenal for the United States Army at a contractual output of 50 R., but upon its completion and testing it was found that the output was actually 100 R. We hope that the same results will be achieved in your machine.
