Dear Wataghin,


After writing you yesterday, I thought of a possible suggestion out of the difficulty of the expense of travel by air. I do not know whether there is any possibility in this direction, and if there is probably it would have already occurred to you, but anyway it will not do any harm to mention it.

The idea would be to get another university, for example the one of Rio, to become interested in my visit and to share part of the traveling expenses. Traveling by airplane would leave me almost two months and a half to spend in Brazil, if the thing could be arranged at once. Of this time I could spend half in S. Paulo and half in Rio (or in different percentages) and the two universities might share the expense, thus increasing the allowance for travel.

I would be willing to lecture on any subject within my capacity, and would have no objection in giving two courses at the same time (say about 6 hours a week) for example one in spectroscopy and one in nuclear physics. Of course I would be very glad if I could in some way help with the experimental work.

In case you think there is something to be done along these lines please inform me as soon as possible.
