Thank you very much for your letter of August 25. I heard from Professor Bexk in Rio, that everything is going to be settled for your trip to Brazil in October. By the way, we would like to know the exact date and place of your arrival.

We do not know if you would like to have an apartment as soon as you arrive here; our suggestion would be to obtain a place for you and your family in a good "pensão" (boarding house) for a month or so. As for the equipment you bring along, the best in order to avoid trouble at the customs is to send at your name on care of the CONSELHO NACIONAL DE PESQUISAS, Avenida Marechal Camara 350, Rio de Janeiro.

On the other hand, we are starting now the necessary steps to obtain a licence for reexportation of the material you bring as a loan of Syracuse University.
