

At Tuesday morning's session we propose to offer a motion concerning Dr. Roger Posadas, formerly of the University of Pittsburgh, who is presently in custody at a military camp under the Martial Law of the Republic of the Phillipines.

He was formally invited to participate in this symposium, but has not been released in time. He has also been invited to participate in the Eighth International Conference on General Relativity and Gravitation in Waterloo, Ontario next summer. The proposed wording of the resolution is as follows:

The participants at the Eighth Texas Symposium on Relativistic Astrophysics note with regret the absence of our colleague Dr. Roger Posadas from our meeting, and respectfully request the Government of the Republic of the Phillipines to enable Professor Posadas of the University of the Phillipines to attend the forthcoming Eighth International Conference on General Relativity and Gravitation, scheduled to take place in August, 1977 at the University of Waterloo, Ont. Canada. Professor Posadas is an internationally known research worker in general relativity. His contributions to the forthcoming meeting will be valuable and greatly appreciated.
